Premium quality network: Salt network improved 4th consecutive year in a row

The 28th edition of the connect mobile network test again confirms that Swiss consumers enjoy an outstanding service quality compared to neighbouring countries and that Salt provides top-level mobile services in Switzerland.



In this year's connect mobile network test, published on November 30, the Salt mobile network was again rated "very good" with 930 of 1000 possible points. Salt was able to improve its score compared to the previous year for the fourth year in a row and therewith made the biggest improvements among national competitors since 2017, with +85 points.

Throughout 2021, Salt has pursued its strategy to continuously invest in the network by modernizing the existing and further deploying its 5G network. These efforts are reflected in the 2021 test results; Salt achieved high performance levels in all three test disciplines.
